**The AKC Agility Course Test** is an entry level agility event designed to introduce beginning dogs and / or handlers to the exciting sport of agility. Dogs must be 15 months or older to enter and must meet the requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3) and may not hold any AKC agility titles, other than an ACT title. Event open to all AKC recognized breeds and mixed breeds. Dogs do not need to be registered with AKC to enter, however to receive a title certificate, a non-registered qualifying dog must complete the registration process.

**ACT Level 1** is open to all dogs that have not earned any AKC agility titles. The course will have 10-12 obstacles to be completed within a maximum of 60 seconds course time. Obstacles include: 5' A-frame, table, open tunnels and bar jumps. Tire and panel jumps may be included. There are no spread jumps (double, triple or broad jump), teeter, dog walk nor weave pole.

**ACT Level 2** is open to all dogs that have not earned an AKC agility title except an ACT 1 title. Level 2 courses will have 11-13 obstacles to be completed within a maximum of 70 seconds course time. Obstacles include those from Level 1 plus a teeter, 6 weave poles, tire and one spread jump (double, triple or broad jump; the dog walk may also be included).

Earning an ACT Title for either level requires two qualifying runs with a minimum score of 85. Refusals and run-outs are not judged. More than 3 attempts at an obstacle will result in an elimination (non-qualifying score). The rest of the faults are the same as in the regular agility classes. All passing scores may be from the same judge.

Dogs may be entered at any of the following jump height divisions: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20 or 24 inches, handler's choice. An AKC jump height card is not required, and dogs will not be measured. Dogs may enter both Level 1 and Level 2 in the same event.

**Running Order:**

ACT 1 (round 1) Small to Tall  
ACT 1 (round 2) Tall to Small  
ACT 2 (round 1) Small to Tall  
ACT 2 (round 2) Tall to Small

**Awards:** Green flat qualifying ribbons will be given to all qualifiers. Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place.

**Notice to Exhibitors**

The safety of the dogs is of primary importance. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all of the obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the show site. There will be no refund of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site. Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the ring or the designated warm-up area. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

AGREEMENT

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge or ACT Evaluator, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. AKC Canine PartnersSM applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
